Progress at the end of KS2

Based on the end of year SATs results and the more accurate teacher assessment our children have shown to have made good progress from KS1 (Y2) to KS2 (Y6). The tests this year, particularly reading, were very challenging and all the pupils and staff must be commended for all their hard work.

Using the latest government measure 0 represents expected progress and even a negative score can be above the floor target. Our scores were all positive – Reading 2.0, Writing 3.5 and Maths 1.4. These are very pleasing figures!

Progress at the end of KS1

Although overall progress/standards were below the national average the children made the progress we expected of them. The new standards were very challenging and both children and staff worked extremely hard to help the children progress.
