Well done to Year 3 and Reception who move their Bee for the least lates.

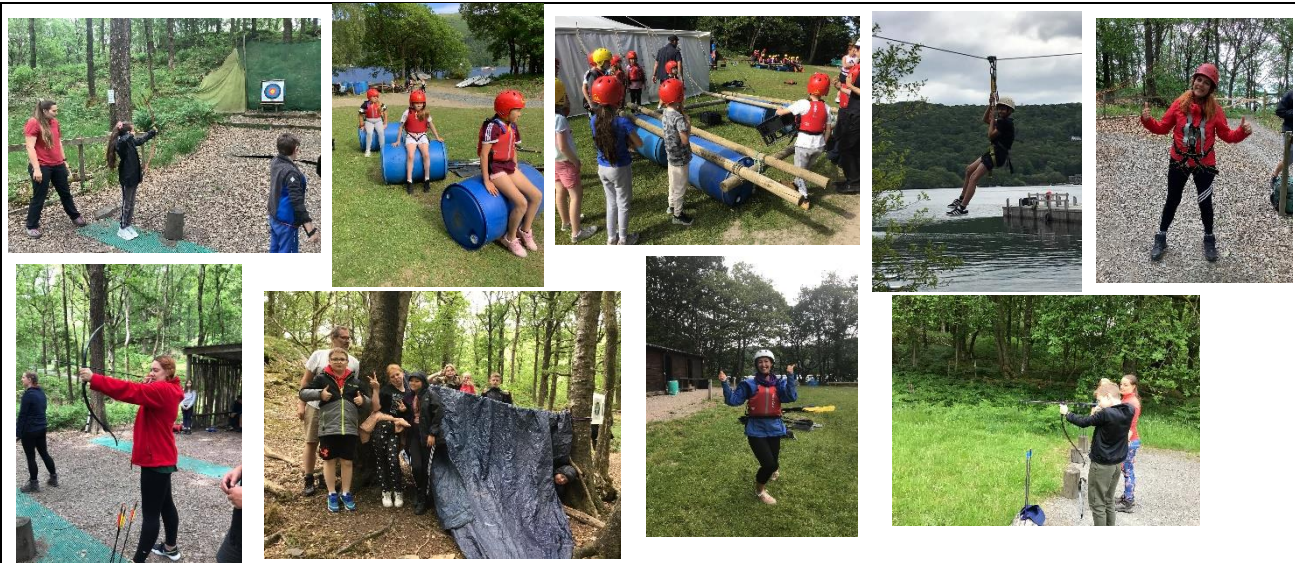
Well done to Year 1 who have earned an extra play for having the best class attendance.

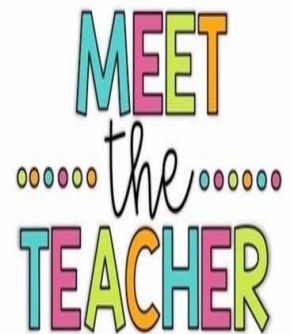
