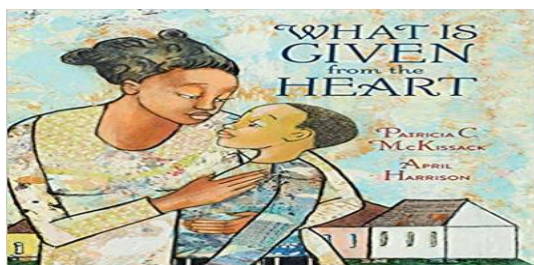
School Value and SMSC Value

These are important values for us to have and show. Please encourage these values in your own home and community, and let your child's teacher know if you notice your child showing these values. One child from each class will be chosen to receive a certificate at the end of the half term if they have continuously shown these values.

School Uniform

We have a number of children who are not wearing school uniform or bending what is allowed.
