Here are the class lates and attendances for the past two weeks Remember the gates will close at 8:55am and if you need to be buzzed in your child will be classed as late:

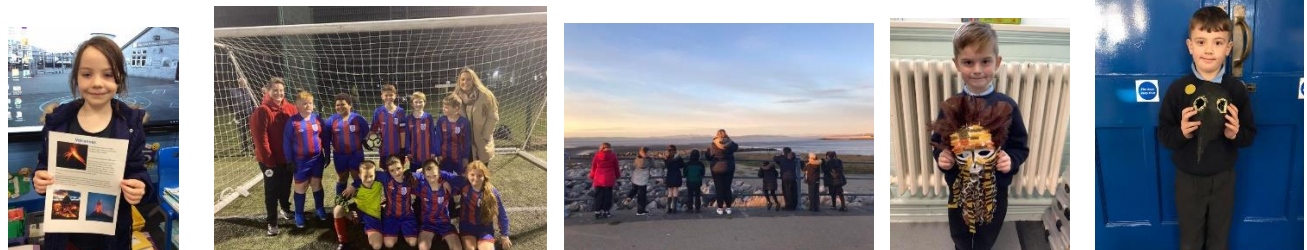

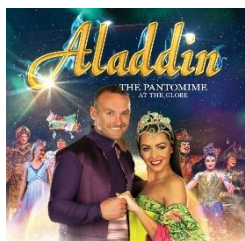
