Expected tasks;

- **Reading** - Daily reading at home is essential. Reading books , signed Reading Record Books and bookmarks must be brought to school **every day**
- **Spelling** - To practise spelling expected Year 2 words.
- **Number skills** - Please continue working on times tables. All children are set up on TT Rockstars or Numbots with the current times tables they are learning. Please practice at home using **TT Rockstars** (your child has their login details in the front of their reading record),

These include TT Rockstars, Lexia (if your child accesses this), Mathletics and more recently Developing Experts. Children can access these outside of school if they wish to.

Design and make a vehicle that would allow you to be an explorer. You could also write some instructions so other children can make it too!




Find out about a famous explorer using the internet and make a fact file about him/her. You could then tell the class what you have found out.
