

Year 3 Homework Spring 2

This half term our topic is *Exciting Egypt*.

You should complete the expected tasks. These do not need to be returned to school.

Expected tasks;

- **Reading** - **Daily** reading at home is **essential**. Reading books and signed Reading Record Books must be brought to school **every day**.
- **Spelling** - To practise spelling expected Year 3 words.
- **Number skills** - Please continue working on the times tables. At the end of each half term we are still asking the children to take a timed times table test. We will be doing lots of work in preparation for this. Please practice at home using **TT Rockstars** (your child has their login details in the front of their reading record), or anywhere as much as you can!
- **Handwriting** - A handwriting book and some handwriting tasks have been sent home as well as the usual homework book. Please practice handwriting using the sheets. Children can write in the handwriting books too, perhaps they can write a story of their choice or about an exciting event.

Extra tasks;

Your target is to complete at least 1 project from the extra task grids. This work must be returned to school before the last week of half term. You will receive a sticker: *GOLD, SILVER* or *BRONZE* to take home.

Write a diary entry as if you were him.



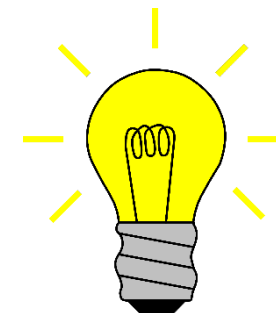
Make an Egyptian mask or design your own gold jewellery.
