

Year 3 Homework Autumn 1

This half term our topic is 'How to Grow a Dragon and Save the World!'

You should complete the expected tasks. These do not need to be returned to school.

Expected tasks;

- **Reading** -Daily reading at home is essential. Your child should read at least 4 times a week to get a sticker. The Reading Record needs to be signed by an adult, to show they have read. Once they have filled their sticker chart they will get a new one and this will be celebrated in our Celebration Assembly. Reading Books and signed Reading Record Books must be brought to school every day.
- **Spelling** - To practise spelling expected Year 3 words. As the year progresses, your child will be given spellings to match their individual needs.
- **Number skills** -Please continue working on the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables previously learnt in Year 2. If your child is confident with all of these then please move onto the 4 times table. This is a great place to begin, as the number rules your child will have picked up from the 2 times table will come into play. To find 4×3 , for example, they can work out 2×3 and double the answer! In Year 4, the children will take a test and are expected to know from 2s up to the 12s. This is a timed test. We will be doing lots of work in preparation for this. Please practice at home or anywhere as much as you can! Please continue to go on TTRs and Mathletics as much as possible!

Extra tasks;

Your target is to complete at least 1 project from the extra task grids. This work must be returned to school no later than Wednesday 18th October 2023. You will receive a sticker: GOLD, SILVER or BRONZE to take home.

In English we will be working on 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' and writing a set of instructions on how to grow your own dragon. Maybe you could write a set of instructions for something else!



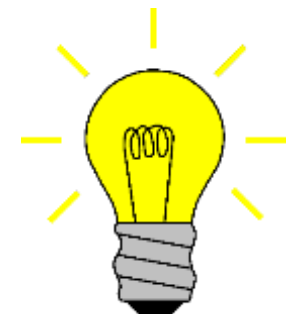
