Find out some facts about The Great Fire of London and make an information sheet or book about it.



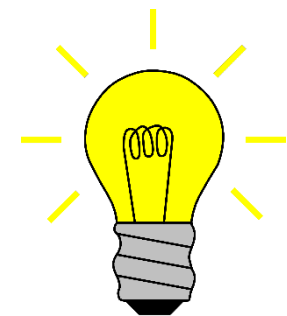
Paint, draw or collage your own Fire of London picture.
